




Core Knowledge In the UK there are 4 seasons each year,

Spring, Summer, Autumn, Winter.

Different seasons have different weather.





Key Vocabulary

| Vocabulary | Definition |
|-------------|--|
| weather | The weather includes the temperature outside, how windy it is and how much it rains. We can also describe cloud, snow and sun. |
| daylight | Daylight is when it is light outside. The amount of daylight changes with each season. |
| temperature | A measure of how hot or cold something is. |

|-------------------|------|-----|-----|-----|-----|-----|-----|-----|-----|------|------|-----|
| Hours of Daylight | 13 | 11 | 9 | 8 | 8 | 10 | 12 | 14 | 15 | 16 | 16 | 14 |
