### Year 3-6 Emile Homework

As part of our KS2 homework, we subscribe to an online resource and app called “Learn with Emile”. This means your child has FREE access to this resource and we would like you to encourage regular use at home. We use this app to support the teaching of spellings, maths and grammar learning. This resource has been shown to have significant improvements in learning outcomes when used regularly.

#### **Spellings on Emile**

Each week, children will receive a list of spellings which are in-line with the National Curriculum. To support the learning of these spellings, there are a series of games and activities, which children will complete via the Emile app or website. These games each have their own code, which will be sent home with the children on their spelling lists. Every three weeks, children will complete a spelling battle (assessment) in class. Children who require additional support with their spellings are assessed by playing the rating game and then allocated games and activities at their level. As the children will be competing in many of the games at their level, there is no reason for anyone to become discouraged.

#### **Grammar and Maths Homework**

Children will be asked to complete a grammar and maths tasks based on prior learning each week. This will be set by the teacher and visible when children log onto Emile. We recommend that, over the week, children should complete the 20 questions on the maths and grammar that have been set for them.
