

<p><u>Rainbow writing</u> Write your words over and over, each time on top of the last but in a different colour- create a rainbow word.</p>	<p><u>Write in colour</u> Write the list of words, each word in a different font/colour.</p>	<p><u>Squiggly / Bubble spelling words</u> Write a list of your spelling words twice - once in your regular writing, then in squiggly or bubble letters.</p>	<p><u>ABC Order</u> Write out each of your spellings and then write them in alphabetical order.</p>	<p><u>Flash Cards</u> Make a set of flashcards to practice your spelling words. When you look at your flashcard, read the word and then spell it out loud.</p>	<p><u>Scrabble spelling</u> Write the letters you need to spell your words, mix them up face down and time how quickly you can unscramble them into the words.</p>	<p><u>Choo- Choo words</u> Write the entire list end-to-end as one long word (like a train). Use a different coloured crayon for each word. Eg hopmopestopdrop</p>
<p><u>Across and down</u> Write all of your spelling words across and then down starting with the first letter. W h e n h e n</p>	<p><u>Spelling Pyramid</u> Write the word by starting with the first letter, then add the next two underneath and so on until you have a pyramid a an ans anwe answer</p>	<p><u>Syllable Splitting</u> Write each word, use a different colour for each syllable. e.g. colourful</p>	<p><u>Dominant handwriting</u> Write each word twice. The first time use your dominant hand and then use your other hand.</p>	<p><u>ZYX Order</u> Write out each of your spellings and then write them in reverse alphabetical order.</p>	<p><u>Write Cover Test</u> Write the word, cover it and then test it.</p>	<p><u>Test</u> Have your partner test you on your spellings twice. Take it in turns to test one another and then do it a second time. Can you both beat your scores?</p>
